Festival of Trees Open House Set for this Sunday

Greeneville, Tenn. – The Festival of Trees Open House will take place this Sunday, from 2 to 4 p.m. at the site in the Greeneville Commons between Q Nails and Southern Belle Bridal. The open house will feature refreshments, music and the opportunity to register for a number to bid on the 17 trees and more than 20 wreaths, centerpieces and nativity scenes that will be offered.

Silent auction bidding will begin at the open house and take place through noon on Tuesday, November 26. Entry fee for the open house is one canned food item that will be donated to the local food bank.
